


Begin our meals together with the sign of the cross and a thanksgiving prayer.

Help me with the responses, prayers and songs in the hymn book.






Invite my sponsor for a meal.

Dear family,

Here are some ways you can help me before our next session.


- Help me find the baptisimal font and holy water stoups when we go to church. Remind me to bring my book to church to complete page 7.



2: Anointed with Oil:



Dear family,

In our second gathering, we again remembered our baptism as we enjoyed God's gift of oil. We learned the words *chrism* and *anoint*. At baptism, we are anointed with chrism to show we are now like Jesus.

We learned that God's family has a special job: to continue Jesus' work by bringing God's love to other people, telling people about God's love, praying for them, and showing them God's ways.

God's family has to work together to help each other. The Holy Spirit will also help. Confirmation is God's promise that the Holy Spirit will always be with me to help me.


Here are some ways you can help me before our next session.

Amen.



Here are some ways you can help me before our next session.


- Trace the sign of the cross on my forehead at bedtime.

- Let's say together the Prayer of St. Francis on page 20.







"1 do!"



Dear family,




