



Fishers of Men

Today's Liturgy of the Word invites us to reflect on two fundamental choices: blessing or curse, life or death. We choose the best when we put our trust in the Lord and live according to this choice. Such is the message of the Beatitudes. The Lord should be our only Treasure, our Friend, our Guide, and our final Reward.

In the Eucharist, we will pray in a special manner for the grace to always stay close to the Lord Jesus and live by the light of his Beatitudes. We will also pray for those who are blinded by their passions and make choices that are destructive of their dignity and endanger their eternal salvation. May all of us see the light and live according to the teaching and example of Jesus.

CALLED TO LOVE AS GOD DOES

Today's theme – LOVE – is both attractive and challenging. In a world characterized by aggressiveness and violence, the concept of Godlike love may seem unrealistic and incapable of solving the problems of justice, stability, and order. Other solutions may appear to be more "effective." But, in the long run, the real solution can be found only in a love that is patterned after God's love for us, for "God knows best"

Such a love is the only way to go beyond the present deficiencies and injustices, and build the Kingdom established by Christ. This is the "new order" characterized by authentic solidarity, compassion, forgiveness, and self-giving – all "family names" of the sublime reality we call "LOVE."
