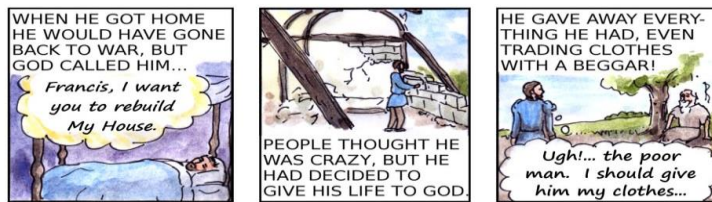
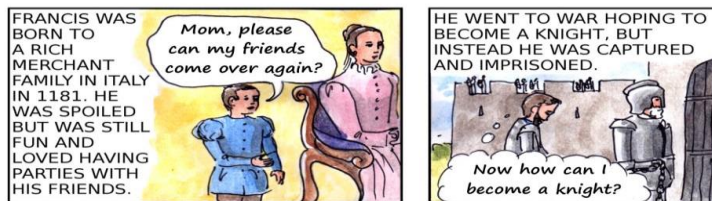

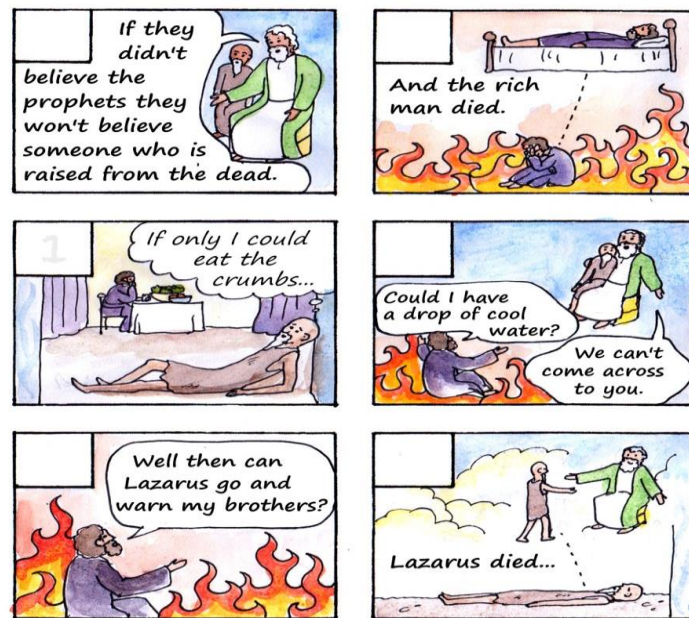
# Saint Francis of Assisi October 4

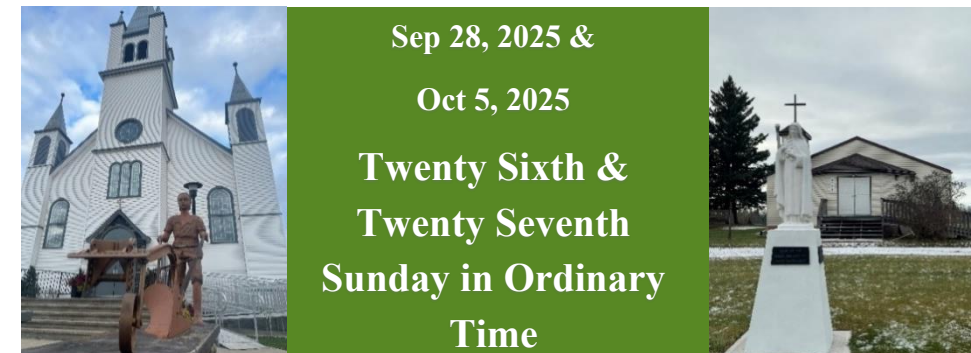

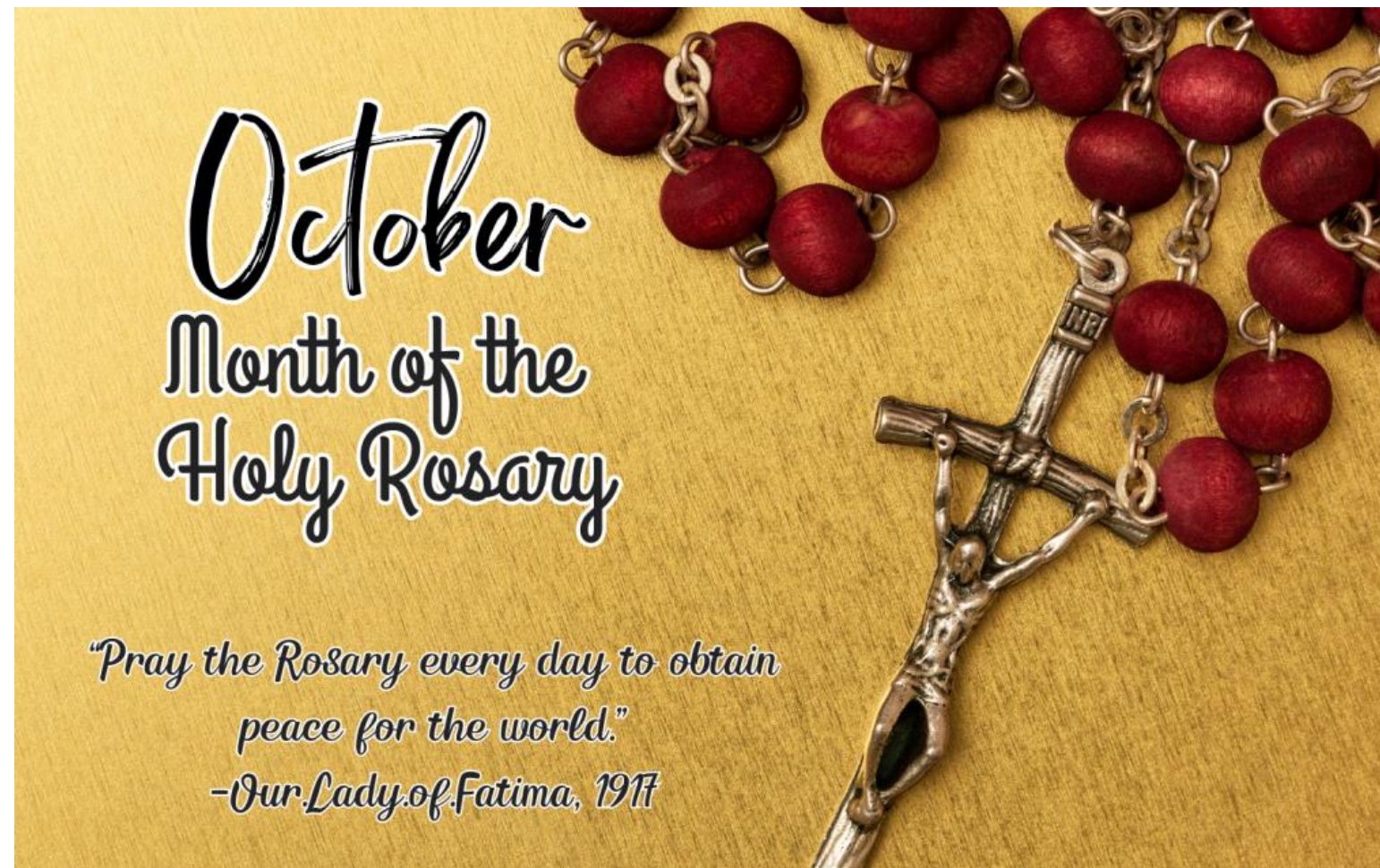


## Announcement Corner

- Thank you to Amanda Gauthier, for bringing the cemetery map to Edmonton for photocopying and having the ability to enter onto the computer as a digital copy.

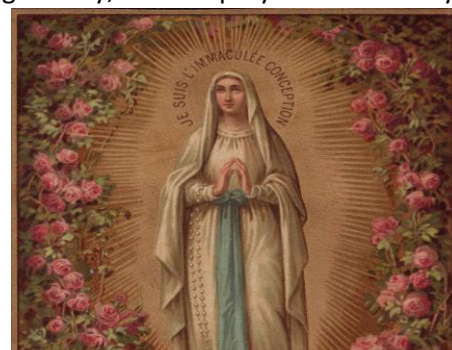
