

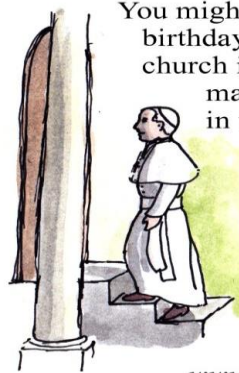
Birthday of the Church's Church!

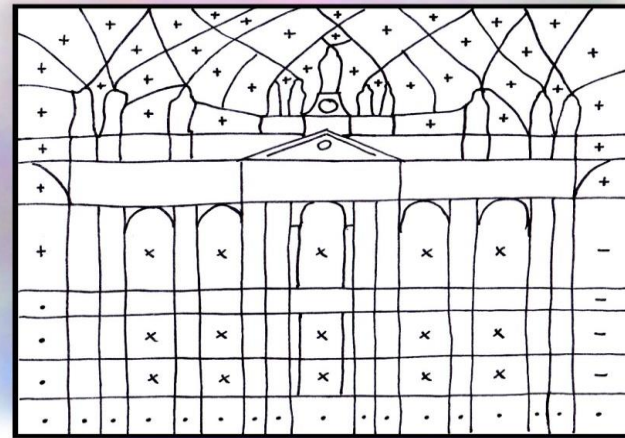

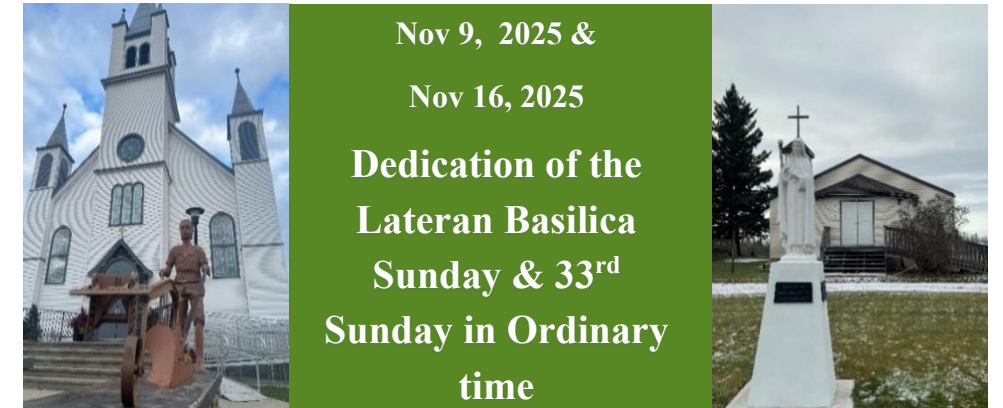

The anniversary of the dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran – the cathedral church of the Pope in Rome – is an invitation to show our love for the Holy Father and renew our union with him. It is also an opportunity to reawaken our awareness that God's temple is not just the place of worship made of stones and cement, but especially the community of believers who are the "living stones" that constitute it.

Today, therefore, is also the feast of our parish community, God's family and living temple in this area. At no other time is this reality more obvious than when we gather to celebrate the Eucharist.

Let us be aware of this wonderful reality of which we are a part. With all our hearts, let us worship the Lord in unison with all those who share our faith and hope, especially those who are suffering, in whatever way.

THE DAY OF RETRIBUTION AND FULFILLMENT

As we approach the end of the liturgical year, the Church invites us to reflect on a very important event that will take place at a time that only God knows: the end of the world.

The purpose of the invitation to reflect on that dramatic event is not to fill us with apprehension, but to bring us to make the right choices **now**. This means to live in a way that will enable us to face those dreadful moments with **trust** and **hope**, knowing that the one who will judge us will be the Lord whom we are doing our best to serve today.

In this Eucharistic celebration, therefore, we will pray for the grace to constantly live in the Lord's presence and in His grace. May He find us doing what is pleasing to Him at whatever time He may wish to come and take us with Him.

Parish Wish List: Some of you have asked what we need money for:

- Number one is Operating Costs – to keep church running (utilities, insurance, wages, supplies, etc.)
 - Apartment in Rectory – washroom reno (new tub, vanity, sink, fixtures, tile, toilet and flooring) and some drywall repairs throughout the apartment. Safety issues: black mold
 - Chapel in basement of rectory-paint walls, repair any cracks, new flooring, replace/repair lighting fixtures, Washroom downstairs – replace toilet and vanity, storage cabinets, cover exposed pipes and new flooring. May also have black mole issues
 - Gravel to fill in potholes and level out parking areas. Eventually, hopefully, pavement.
