## Our Lenten Journey with Jesus, the Life-Giving Water

The Third Sunday of Lent invites us to reflect on the theme of water. Like the Samaritan woman, we are all invited to ask for the life-giving water that flows from Jesus—His teaching and grace, the cleansing of sin through His death and resurrection, and the water of His Spirit, which alone satisfies our longing for love and meaning.

We were given these gifts at baptism and continue to receive them whenever we approach the Lord in faith and love. Today, as we gather around the altar, let us recall the gift of our baptism and offer the life-giving sacrifice of the Eucharist to the Father.



## Jesus Shows His Glory



In today's Gospel reading Jesus took three of His apostles up a mountain and gave them a vision of His true glory. He shone as bright as the sun- so bright they could hardly look at Him. But did you know that what they saw was only a tiny bit of the true glory of God?

It was so beautiful that Peter wanted Him to stay that way. He offered to build tents for Jesus and Moses and Elijah, who appeared with Him. But the joy of that moment wasn't meant to last forever. It was just a little taste of Heaven.

Jesus gave this experience to the three apostles just a little while before He went to Jerusalem to suffer and die on the cross. He knew that they would be terrified and very sad when He died so He gave them a preview of the glory He would go back to after He rose from the dead. That way they knew they had a reason to hope even when He was killed.

Sometimes we have awful things to suffer through too. Maybe a friend will move away or one of our grandparents will die. But we never have to give up hope because we know that eventually everyone who loves Jesus will live in total happiness in Heaven.

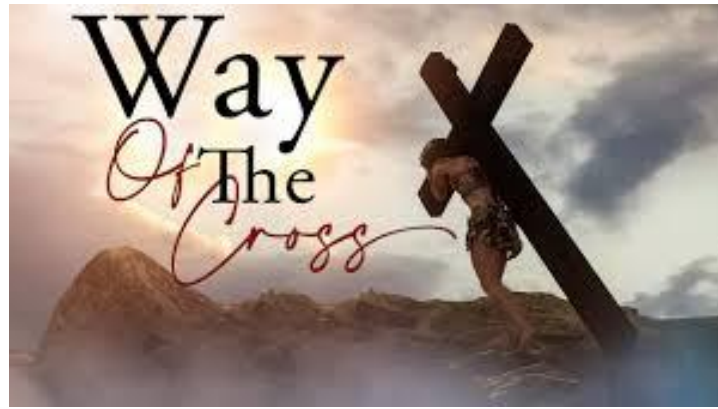
